
### International Credit Union Day - October 18

### Online Banking and eServices for Members

This Spring, Montana FCU launched our new Online Banking and Billpay platform. This platform offers all the same benefits as our previous Online Banking program, along with additional features including a personal financial management tool and enhanced Billpay functionality. We also have a valuable eServices program that includes eStatements, eLetters, and eAlerts. eStatements give you all the features of our paper statements, delivered securely to Online Banking. The utilization of eStatements by our members helps your credit union save money on printing and postage and helps eliminate paper waste. eLetters allow the credit union to deliver routine correspondence to you in an electronic format, also saving time and money. Finally, subscribing to eAlerts allows you to set certain parameters on your accounts that will cause an alert to be sent via email or text message. Examples of eAlerts include notifications that loan payments are due, posting of debit card transactions, low balance notifications, etc. You have the ability to choose which eAlerts you would like to utilize.
